EDST 572 Research, Writing, and Representation

EDST 572 is a required course in the EDST MA program. We explore issues and problems associated with academic writing and the representation of knowledge in education as a field of scholarship, broadly defined. A key purpose of the course is to engage in writing and revision aimed towards the completion of your program. **Completion of EDST 571 is a prerequisite for this course.**

Some questions that guide the course:

What is effective academic writing? what are some of its myriad forms, and what form works best for me?

What are some critical challenges in representing the “voice” of (often marginalized) others in academic research and writing?

What can educational researchers learn from controversies surrounding misrepresentation in writing and research?

What are your writing strengths and challenges and how can this course help improve your writing and reviewing skills?
