Review of Research in Educational Studies Methods 1 – Introduction to Indigenous Methodology

This course introduces students to some of the community and academic considerations for conducting research with Indigenous communities and people. Historically, there have been many problems in Indigenous research conducted by outsiders due to a wide range of approaches. This course will provide an introduction to Indigenous cultural differences, place based Indigenous knowledge, the protocols around protecting knowledge, and the roles and perspectives of researchers. Students will develop an approach to work with Indigenous communities and people, consider ethics and methodological questions for entering into research relationships with Indigenous communities.
