KEYNOTE SPEAKER

DR. ANTHONY PARÉ
LANGUAGE & LITERACY EDUCATION, FACULTY OF EDUCATION, UBC



Dr. Paré is Professor and Head of the Language and Literacy Education Department, at the University of British Columbia and Professor Emeritus at McGill University. He has numerous publications on academic writing, particularly in the context of doctoral education. His work calls for a re-conceptualization of writing in the doctorate, one which would encourage EdD and PhD students to experience a wide range of genres, readers, and writing tasks.

In his talk, titled "Putting writing to work," Dr. Paré will present a brief overview of writing theory and research, explore the challenges of doctoral writing, and offer suggestions on ways to make the task easier and more manageable.
